Here are some questions you can ask your doctor and health care team:

- What type of immunotherapy will I get?
- How often will I get treatment?
- How long will my treatment last?
- Where will I go to get my treatment?
- Can I drive myself to treatment?
- Will my insurance pay for my treatment?
How much will I have to pay?
- What side effects could I have?
- How can my side effects be managed and what can I do about them?
- Will I be able to work and do my regular activities during treatment?
- Can I continue taking my other medications and supplements during treatment?
- Will I need other types of treatment?
- When should I call the doctor or nurse?
